

# Southall Local Collection Point Volunteer Delivery Driver



Where?	You'll be required to collect & return the van to Southall. You will be driving to Deptford to collect the food orders for charities which will be dropped off at one location in Southall. It is a single return trip.
When?	Wednesday mornings, finishing at approximately 1pm
How often?	Once a week for a minimum commitment of 3 months

**FareShare London** redistributes surplus food to charities and community groups across the capital, who turn it into meals for vulnerable people. We operate a warehouse in Deptford, South East London, where we sort and store surplus food and then deliver it on our vans to our member charities and community groups across London.

This role is vital to the work of FareShare, ensuring that food is safely delivered to our Community Food Members via the Southall Local Collection Point. This role is perfect for someone who enjoys getting out and about in London, someone looking to gain experience in the food industry, warehousing and customer service and/or someone just wanting to help.

## What will I be doing?

- Safely driving vans around London to deliver and collect food
- Representing FareShare in a courteous and professional manner at all times
- Carrying out routine checks on the vans, taking responsibility for the vans throughout the day and reporting accidents or damage to the van or other vehicles.
- Completing all relevant paperwork
- Planning routes, sorting food, picking orders, loading and unloading vans.
- Assist in the maintenance of the vans including cleaning.

## We need you to be:

- Held a full, clean driving license for three years
- Able to perform physical tasks (lifting and loading abilities are desirable)
- Confident to drive a medium-sized van (experience is preferable)
- Able to work well in a team, on your own and under pressure
- Able to work effectively and use your initiative in a fast-paced role
- Able to follow our systems and procedures, food safety legislation and the Highway Code
- Available to commit to a reoccurring day each week
- Flexible - there may be times when we ask you to help on other projects/tasks
- Good at map reading and/or able to use a Sat Nav system

## What you can expect in return:

- Support and supervision from FareShare London staff
- An induction and training for the role (inc. Food Safety and Hygiene Level 2)
- Reasonable travel expenses and a free lunch
- Invitations to events and offers to get involved in other areas of FareShare's work
- A work reference for those who have satisfactorily committed to at least 3 months
