A community planting day will take on:

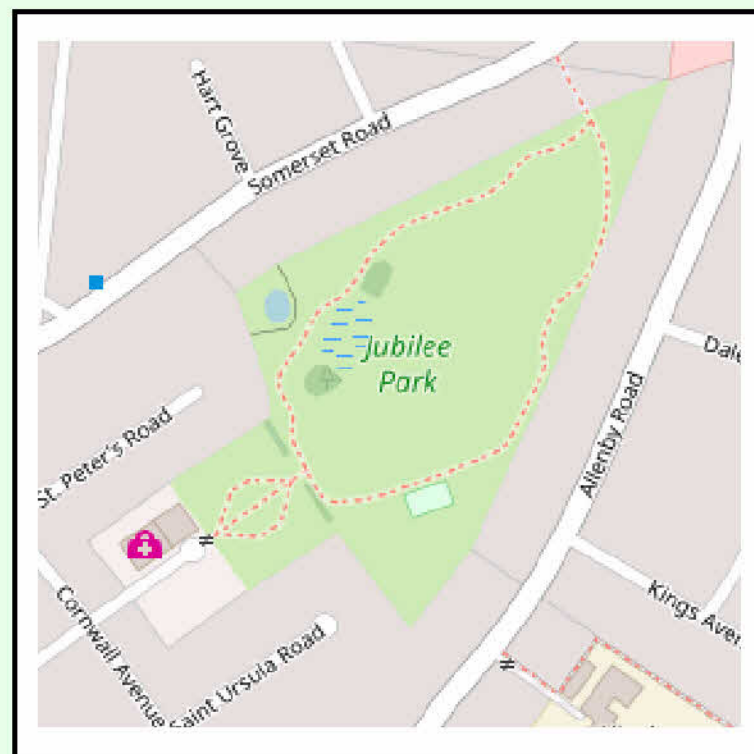
