The Southall Orchard Project is a community led initiative aimed at planting orchards and fruiting hedges throughout Southall. The goal is to have at least five orchards in place by 2020. The first three orchards were planted between 2015 and 2018 at Southall Park, Southall Recreation Ground and Jubilee Park.
